



- More fun


## Different models

- By deal
  - Each member decides how to invest by deal
- Pledge syndicate
  - Members pledge to invest a minimum if majority vote
- Fund syndicate
  - Invest in fund, majority vote
- Fund
  - Invest in fund, others manage
- Online Syndicates
  - Single deal VC. Co-invest w-th lead who gets a carry

## Cairo Angels

# Egypt's first & only formal network of business angels.

- Founded in 2012 as entrepreneurial eco-system in Egypt grew to focus on early-stage companies
- 80 members (in 6 cities globally)
- Invested \$1.8 million in 15 start-ups across a variety of industries
- Regional leader
  - Co-founded MENA Angel Investor Network
  - Hosting African Angels Investors Summit in October



## **London Angels**

To engage Egyptians based in London to invest in start ups in Egypt and in the region.

- Meet quarterly at London Business School to watch pitch event in Cairo live via Google Hangouts
- 12 active members (mostly first time angels)
- 6 have invested in at least one company
- 2 have led due diligence from London
- 2 have brought in deals



## How to build a diaspora network

- 1. Establish a strong local network at home first
- 1. A "champion" & "anchor" angel investors to lead, mobilize networks & give credibility
- 1. Utilize technology but make it personal
- 1. Ensure diaspora and home network ties are strong

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### Origin of the idea



#### Came out of NY Digital Irish group

- Founded December 2012
- 950 Members
- 70 Startup pitches so far
- Focus on entrepreneur "asks" and introductions





### How we started it

- From thinking big to small
- Key advisor(s)
- Filtering firms to pitch
- Targeting list of investors
- Getting platform going
- Locking date & location down







### **Event Details and Format**

- Attendee stats
- Format of event
- Explaining investment options
- Guidance on target investment level

### Follow up

- Due diligence
- Closing people down!





### **Lessons Learned**

- Start small!
- Don't underestimate the effort
- Better ways to structure things?
- Still a work in process
